...or is it a chance to play the games you love for 48 uninterrupted hours, with people who are ready to throw down with equal intensity?

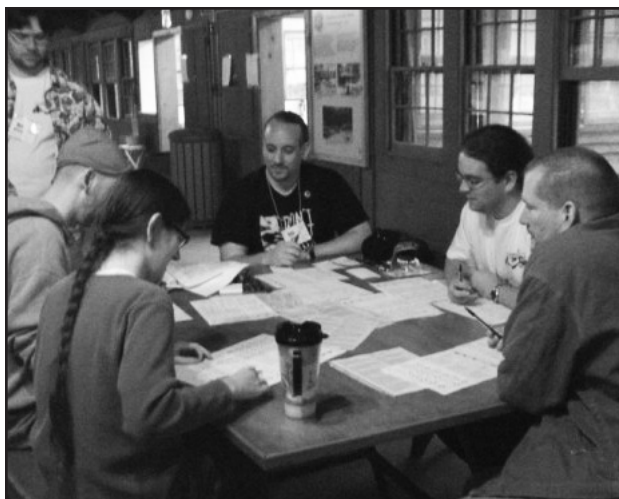
Is it relaxing? Is it brimming with excitement?

# CAMPING AND GAMING

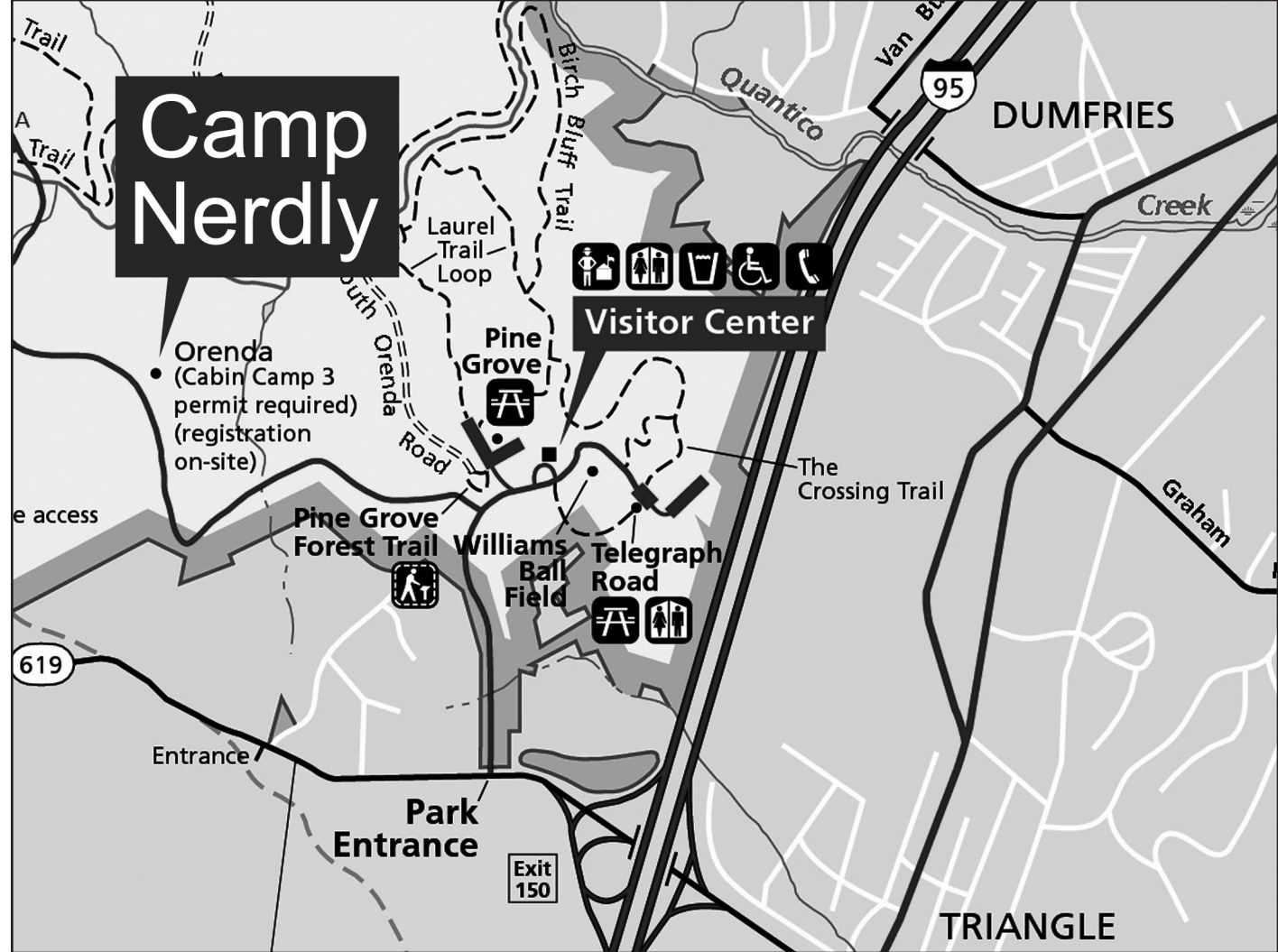
You won't exactly be roughing it, but if this is your first trip to Camp Nerdly, here is a list of useful stuff:

## DIRECTIONS

Camp Nerdly is conveniently located in the Prince William Forest national park, just outside Triangle, Virginia.

Take I-95 to exit 150. At the bottom of the exit ramp turn onto 619 (right if coming from DC and points north; left if coming from Richmond and points south). Follow it to the park entrance (It isn't far).

## AT THE PARK

Upon arrival, check in at the visitor center to get a parking permit (\$5). Then drive back around to the Orenda campground parking lot. You can drive up to the actual camp to drop off your stuff, but you'll have to park in the lot and hoof it normally.

Say hello and let Camp Nerdly staff know you've arrived. If you need any help, holler! There will be plenty of freindly campers ready to assist.
